On February 15-17, 2013 the Pheasants Forever organization hosted the National Pheasant Fest & Quail Classic in Minneapolis, MN where 28,855 outdoor enthusiasts



attended. This year marked the 30th anniversary for Pheasants Forever. Pheasant Fest & Quail Classic is a trade show that focuses on wildlife conservation, upland game bird hunting (pheasant and quail), dog training, and wildlife habitat management and restoration. The show is open to the public and is the nation's leading event for bird dog owners and sporting dog enthusiasts where they can meet with dog clubs, breeders and some the best trainers in the world including Delmar Smith, Rick Smith and Ronnie Smith.
